| Theme                       | "No One Left Behind"   |
| Entry Fee                   | \$15 per entrant for residents of Phoenix. No fee for residents of any one of Phoenix's ten sister cities.                                   |
| Submittal                   | Poems are requested to be submitted by e-mail as <b>Word</b> files. E-mail to <u>office@aiccd.net</u>  |
| Requirements                | Poems must be submitted with a cover note listing the author's name, address and phone number.   |
|                             | The name must not be on the poem itself.   |
|                             | Poems must be submitted in English. Poems not submitted in English will be sent to individual  |
|                             | PSC committee members. If poems cannot be translated by individual PSC committee members, or   |
|                             | other qualified persons, poems will be translated through a computerized program.  |
|                             | Subject matter is open but must be consistent with the theme.  |
|                             | • Entries not conforming to contest rules will be disqualified; entry fees will not be returned.   |
| Judging                     | A panel of judges will evaluate entries based on theme interpretation, composition, and originality.   |
